NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVOKE LICENSES

Dear Abdinoor Dolal:

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend revocation of the Taxicab Vehicle licenses for Cab # 1975 and Cab #5386 held by Twin Cities Taxi & Town Car Service Inc. d/b/a Twin Cities Cab for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is based on the following information:

According to DSI records, your service company no longer meets the minimum of five (5) active licensed taxicabs in its fleet. Saint Paul Legislative Code § 376.10 (b) (2) requires that: "...A service company must maintain a minimum of five (5) licensed vehicles. If the number of licensed vehicles drops below five (5), the remaining licenses shall be revoked."

At this time, you have two (2) options how to proceed:

1. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter no later than **Friday, February 7, 2014**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to revoke your Taxicab Vehicle licenses for Cab # 1975 and Cab #5386. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.

2. If you dispute the facts outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). I will need to receive your letter no later than **Friday, February 7, 2014**. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation.

Please note: If you choose an administrative hearing, the Department of Safety and Inspections reserves the right to request that City Council impose the costs of the administrative hearing per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (k).

If you have not contacted me or DSI by Friday, February 7, 2014, I will assume that you do not contest the revocation of you Taxicab Vehicle licenses for Cab # 1975 and Cab #5386. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
