Resolution in Support of The Waters of Highland Park Application for a Beer and Wine Liquor license and a Waiver of the 45 Day Waiting Period

WHEREAS, The Waters of Highland Park has applied for a wine and beer on sale license at 678 Snelling Ave. South with the City of Saint Paul; and

WHEREAS, the Highland District Council's Community Development Committee met with the applicant, in July of 2016 to discuss the business, operations and request for a beer and wine license, and the waiver of the 45 day wait period of that license ; and

WHEREAS, there have been no concerns from neighbors, and the conditions on the license will remain the same; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of the Highland District Council supports the request for a beer and wine license with a waiver of the 45 day wait period for The Waters of Highland Park at 678 Snelling Ave South, as long as all license requirements are met and conditions are followed.
