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

Conditions are as follows:

1. The licensee shall pick up trash, litter, and empty bottles and/or cans in the immediate vicinity of the licensed business, whether on public or private property, at least on a daily basis.
2. The licensee shall promptly remove graffiti from the premises in accordance with applicable City Ordinances.
3. 3.2 Beer and beer products cannot be sold by the individual bottle or can.
4. The sale of 40 ounce bottles and/or cans of beer is not permitted. The sale of beer in containers of this or similar sizes is considered to be the sale of beer by the individual bottle or can.
5. The sale of wine and/or strong beer is not permitted with a Malt Off Sale license.
6. The license holder shall maintain working video surveillance cameras inside and outside the establishment in accordance with the Saint Paul Police Department (SPPD) recommendations. There shall be a minimum of seven (7) cameras on the inside of the establishment and three (3) on the outside, with adequate lighting to support the camera placement. The video recordings shall be kept by the license holder for at least thirty (30) days and shall be available for viewing by the SPPD immediately upon request. In addition, if the SPPD responds to a call at the licensed premises, and due to the serious nature of the crime, requests that a copy of the surveillance footage be immediately provided, the license holder shall have technology available to make the copy at the time of the request and shall have it for the police without delay. In other cases, if the SPPD or the Department of Safety and Inspections requests copies of the surveillance tapes, the licensee shall have a forty-eight (48) hour period in which to provide such copies.
7. Cashiers shall verify the age of a customer by checking state or federally issued picture identification cards prior to each sale of a Malt (i.e., beer) product. There shall be no sale of Malt products to any customer who does not have a valid picture ID.
