Line 8 –

Normal Construction Hours are 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

In order to minimize disruption to public and adjoining property owners, there may be occasions where work needs to be completed between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM. If sound level variance approved, proposed process for completing work between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM is as follows:

- Metropolitan Council to submit request in writing to Department of Safety and Inspections as to the specific date, time, location and operation where work proposed between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM
- Department of Safety and Inspections, in consultation with Department of Public Works, will review and approve or deny the specific request.
- If specific request approved, Metropolitan Council to notify property owners within 200' of proposed work in writing 72 hours prior to work

Line 9 -

The Contractors and Utility Companies working on the project will use best practicable methods for controlling noise. Construction activities will be scheduled to minimize noise as much as possible in the early morning hours. Construction activities between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM will only be done if there are no other reasonable alternatives.
