Dear Ammar Alfuraui:

The Department of Safety and Inspections ("Department") will recommend adverse action and upward departure one box on the penalty matrix to the imposition of a \$2,000 fine and 10 day suspension against the Cigarette/Tobacco license held by Ammar Alfuraui ("Licensee") for the premises known as Twins Market & Meat located at 1055 4th Street East in Saint Paul. ("Licensed Premises").

Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.06 (b)(6)(a) allows for adverse action to be taken against a License when "The licensee or applicant (or any person whose conduct may be law be imputed to the licensee or applicant) has violated or performed any act which is a violation of, any of the provisions of these chapters or of any statute, ordinance or regulation reasonably related to the licensed activity, regardless of whether criminal charges have or have not been brought in connection therewith".

Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05(m)(2) provides for a presumptive penalty of \$1,000 for a second violation of a provision of the legislative code related to the licensed activity. Under §310.05(m) penalties are presumed to be appropriate, "however the council may deviate therefrom in an individual case where the council finds and determines that there exist substantial and compelling reasons making it more appropriate to do so".

Saint Paul Legislative Code §324.07(f) prohibits a licensee from selling, offering for sale, or otherwise distributing any flavored products.

The Department of Safety and Inspections asserts that the substantial and compelling reasons for upward departure include:

- the number of violations observed and documented by Inspector Voyda; and
- failure to correct the violations after education and imposition of the prior \$1,000 matrix penalty on .

The Department asserts the following facts along with attachments herein constitute proof of a violation of Saint Paul Legislative Code §324.07(f) by a preponderance of the evidence.

Synopsis of Alleged Facts:

On September 10, 2020 the Licensee received a Notice of Violation after an inspection uncovered a large number of flavored products at the Licensed Premises. Inspector Voyda discussed the violation with the Licensee and instructed him to immediately remove all flavored products from the Licensed Premises. The Licensee paid his \$1,000 matrix penalty on September 25, 2020.

On October 8, 2020 Inspector Voyda and Sgt. Graupman returned to the Licensed Premises to perform a follow up inspection. They introduced themselves to the clerk, later identified as Hassan Abbasoleiwi Alrubaye and asked him if he would call the Licensee and let him know that they were there for a follow up inspection. Mr. Alrubaye called the Licensee and there was no answer. Inspector Voyda then asked Mr. Alrubaye if they could look behind the counter in order to conduct his inspection and Mr. Alrubaye told him he could. Inspector Voyda observed multiple flavored products behind the counter, cash register and in the change bin. Inspector Voyda documented his findings with photographs. The inspection and the flavor violations were also documented on Sergeant Graupman's body worn camera.

As the Licensee you have four (3) options:

- 1. If you do not contest the imposition of the proposed adverse action, you may do nothing. If I have not heard from you by **November 16, 2020**, I will presume that you have chosen not to contest the proposed adverse action and the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the proposed remedy.
- 2. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the \$2000.00 and 10 day suspension matrix penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing no later than **November 16, 2020**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council to determine whether to impose the \$2,000.00 and 10 day suspension matrix penalty. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 3. If you dispute the facts outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). You will need to send me a letter disputing the facts and requesting an administrative hearing no later than **November 16**, **2020**. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation.

Please note: If you choose an administrative hearing, the Department of Safety and Inspections reserves the right to request that City Council impose the costs of the administrative hearing, per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (k).

If you have not contacted me by November 16, 2020, I will assume that you do not contest the imposition of the \$2,000- and 10-day matrix penalty. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.





NARRATIVE

I, Sgt C. Graupman am currently assigned to the Department of Safety & Inspection, located at 375 Jackson St. As part of my regular duties, I review police reports and complaints that involve nuisance related activity that negatively effects the quality of life of neighboring residents and citizens in the city of St. Paul. I also assist DSI Licensing Inspectors with monitoring, reviewing and recording activities at businesses that pertain to their current licensing conditions. This is done to ensure that businesses are operating within the licensing conditions that they are mandated to follow by the City of St. Paul and that public safety is regarded while doing so.

Recently, Adverse Action had been taken by the Department of Safety & Inspection (DSI) against the Twins Market & Meat, located at 1055 4th St. E for licensing violations that included the sales of flavored tobacco products. These violations were documented under SPPD CN's 20-166-436 & 20-174-058. A notice of violation letter was sent out on 9-10-20, by the City Attorney's Office recommending an upward departure one box on the matrix penalty scale to \$1,0000 against the Cigarette/Tobacco license held by Ammar Alfuraui (licensee). A re inspection of the premise was then arranged and directed to be conducted by DSI Licensing Inspector Joe Voyda and myself.

It should be noted that in the past one year period between 10-8-19 & 10-8-20, this property has generated 58 police calls, in which 39 of them were not proactive police visits. They include calls related to narcotics use, weapons discharge and disorderly behavior. These remaining 39 incidents have had a large and negative effect on the quality of life in and around the surrounding community and pose a significant threat to public safety.

On 10-8-20 at 1010hrs, I accompanied DSI Licensing Inspector Joe Voyda with a follow up inspection of the

business. During our visit I was wearing my SPPD issued Body Worn Camera (BWC), which captured the inspection. Upon entry into the store, Inspector Voyda made contact with the lone employee who was later identified by MN ID as (ALRUBAYE, HASAN ABBASOLEIWI DOB/12-11-1989). Inspector Voyda identified himself and I. ALRUBAYE was then informed of the purpose of our visit and that it was in reference to a previous inspection completed on 8-21-20. Inspector Voyda added that the purpose was to ensure that the business was remaining compliant with City ordinance 324.07 (f). I stood by while Inspector Voyda received consent from ALRUBAYE to enter the area behind the counter and perform his inspection. During the inspection, I observed Inspector Voyda locate flavored tobacco products in the sales area. These products were hidden in the change bin and behind the counter cash register area. Inspector Voyda advised me that he also located a single pack of Newport menthol cigarettes with no tax stamp. When ALRUBAYE was asked about this he could not give a further explanation. Inspector Voyda checked several other areas within the store and advised his inspection was complete. Inspector Voyda then advised ALRUBAYE to remove all flavored products from behind the sales area and place them in the back cooler until they could be removed from the premise. Contact information was left with ALRUBAYE and we cleared from the scene.

PUBLIC NARRATIVE

On 10-8-20, at 1010 hrs, St. Paul Police assisted the Department of Safety & Inspection with conducting an inspection at 1055 4th St. E. This inspection was in reference to a previous complaint of license violations that had been documented on 8-12-20 & 8-21-20 by St. Paul Police in separate reports under SPPD CN 20-166-436 & 20-174-058. During the inspection, on 10-8-20, licensing violations were observed by both the DSI Licensing inspector and a St. Paul, Police Sergeant. The violations witnessed included the presence of flavored tobacco products and a single container of menthol cigarettes that were behind the front counter in the sales area. he business is currently not authorized to sell flavored tobacco products. Incident documented and photos taken by Licensing Inspector. Case will be forwarded to the City Attorney's Office for Adverse Action review.
