The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A FOLLOW UP WILL BE MADE ON OR AFTER JANUARY 4, 2011. - January 4, 2011.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.
