NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Run or Dye, 5K Fun Run

TO: CapitolRiver Council District 17, West Seventh/Fort Road Federation, and West Side Community Organization

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request.

Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: Harriet Island

Noise Source: Viral Events has requested a sound level variance to provide amplified music and the use of a sound system for announcements at the run start chute to be located at Harriet Island Park for the Run or Dye, 5K Fun Run.

The variance is requested for the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 26, 2014.

The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions:

- Sound levels at the start chute will not exceed 85 dBA at 50 feet
- Sound levels at the stage sound mix or 50 feet from the stage will not exceed 85 dBA
- All electronically powered loudspeakers, PA systems or similar devices will be turned off no later than 12:30 p.m.
