The analysis has identified equipment and training that is in need of replacement/upgrading. We will upgrade our explosive containment trailer which will expand our ability to cover a larger area and also enable us to respond to multiple events simultaneously. We are currently limited in transportation capability. We will also use the investment to upgrade our response tools to more advanced techniques currently identified by DHS and the FBI. This will include above and below water tools. including maritime equipment.

We will also continue to identify training which addresses this type of response.


