Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on February 28, 2013. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on or after March 20, 2013.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Stock Area - MSFC 315.2 - Provide and maintain at least 2 feet clearance below the lowest structural member of the ceiling.-Maintain 2 feet clearance between the combustible storage and the ceiling.
