Your building was inspected on August 2, 2010 for the renewal of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy and was approved. When the required fee has been paid you will receive your certificate. There are however seasonal or non-life safety deficiencies noted below which must be corrected prior to re-inspection.

Are-inspection will be made on or after September 3, 2010.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- Basement Northeast Bedroom Egress Window MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an 1. exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-The construction of the deck stairway is causing an exit obstruction out the northeast basement bedroom egress window. There is only 14-inches clear width between the stairway and the window when the window is in the fully open position. Provide a minimum accessible net clear opening of 9 square feet, with a minimum dimension of 36inches. Refer to EW-1 handout for additional information.
- Egress Windows Basement North and Northeast Bedrooms MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an 2. approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

Basement North and Northeast Bedroom (Casement)

14 w x 35 h - Openable 20 w x 35 h - Glazed

Exterior - Yard - SPLC 34.08 (3) - Provide and maintain suitable ground cover on all exterior areas to 3. control erosion.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer. Applications for appeals may be obtained at the Office of the City Clerk, 310 City Hall, City/County Courthouse, 15 W Kellogg Blvd, Saint Paul MN 55102 Phone: (651-266-8688) and must be filed within 10 days of the date of this order.
