Motor Officer rider safety suit (also keeps officer warm, dry and cool)					
Please describe the situation, issue or need for this project:					
<p>Currently the motors unit does not have a tactically safe rider safety suit. There is no protection on the legs and no padding on the upper body. Current rider jacket attaches the duty belt around the jacket does not secure the duty belt on the belt attached to the pants like most uniforms. There also is a need for a riding suit that can be worn in the extreme temperatures and weather in Minnesota.</p>					
Please describe the specifics of the project, how it will be carried out, and goals to address the situation above:					
<p>The rider safety suit we are attempting to purchase would solve these problems. The Motoport suit is made of a breathable Kevlar mesh that provides protection in the event of a crash due to the abrasion resistant material and crash padding in key points in the suit. The suit also solves the issue of most riding suits where the gun belt attaches to the pants like the standard police uniform. Which will make the officer safer since they will not have to disregard the years of muscle memory from training with the gun belt attached to their pants. The Motoport suit also can be worn and keep the rider dry and warm during both cold (-20F) and hot (120F) weather do to the removable liner (waterproof/windproof/breathable). Further benefits of the suit is the ability to attach reflective stripes up the arms, legs and across the back. Which will improve the rider visibility both during the day and night.</p>

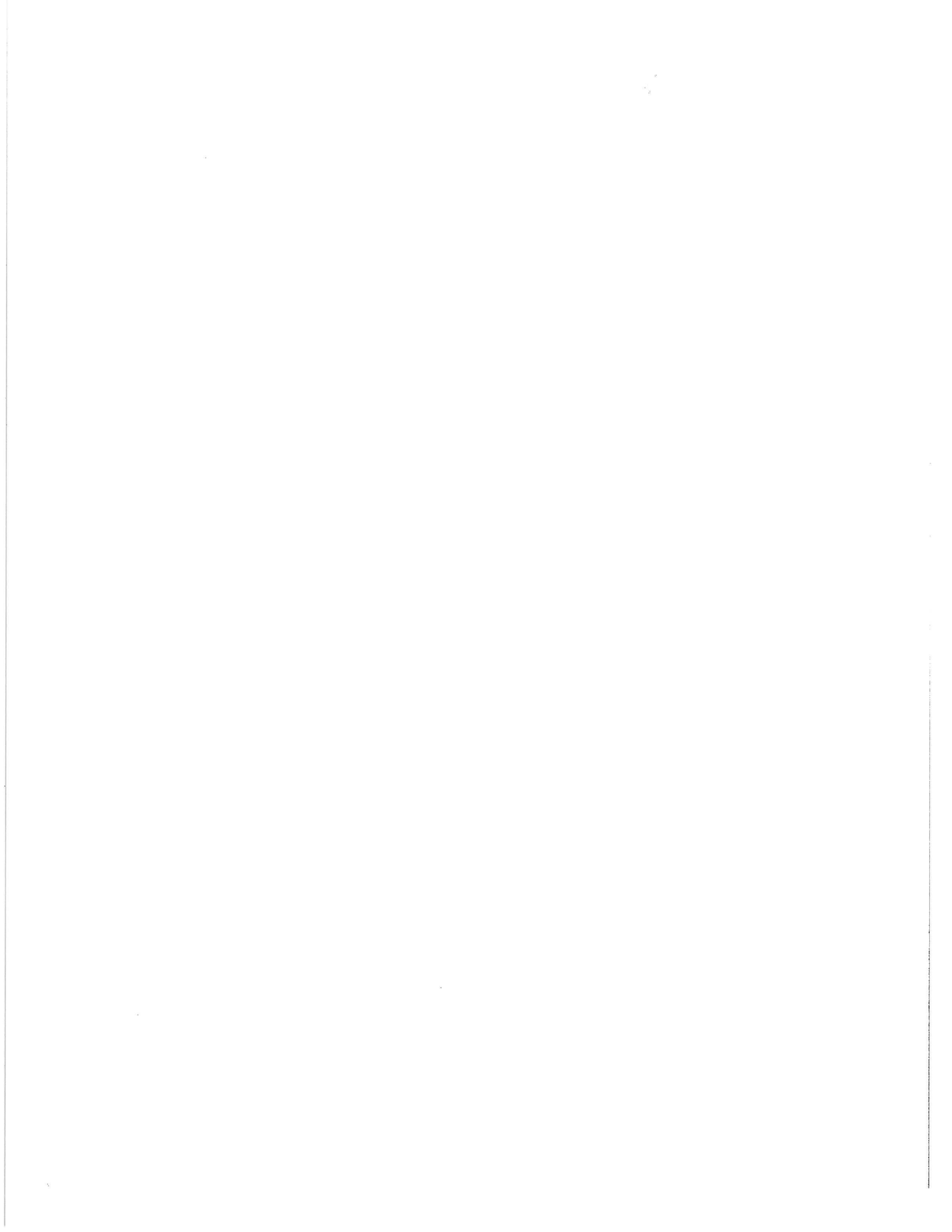

The suit will also protect the officer from the elements from -20F to 120f with protection from wind and rain. It was also add viability with reflective stripes down legs, arms and across back. *Boot And glove grip and Sidi will add extra traction in inclement weather.*
