The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- Basement MSFC 315.3.3 Remove combustible storage within 36 inches of fuel burning equipment.-
- 2. Unit 1 - Basement - SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.34(2) - Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate balustrade must not be more than 6 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.-

- 3. Unit 2 1st Bedroom MSFC 1030.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- Egress window obstructed.
- 4. Unit 2 2nd Bedroom on right MSFC 1030.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- A/C in egress window.
- 5. Unit 2 Left Bedroom MSFC 1030.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- Window opens onto porch.
- 6. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
