3. Both sides of structure - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the window glass.-

4. Entry steps - Front of property - SPLC 34.08 (10) - Repair, replace and maintain exterior
sidewalks, walkways and stairs.-Repair / replace steps .
5. Garage - SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) - All accessory structures including, but not limited to,
detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide
and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Scrape and paint.
6. Retaining wall - Front of property - SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) - All accessory structures
including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound

and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Repair / replace

7. Thru-out - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) -Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.- Missing and torn screens.
