1639 BEECH ST is a Registered Vacant Building that requires a Code Compliance Inspection per the City of St. Paul's Vacant Building Statute (Chapter 43). This dwelling cannot be occupied without a Certificate of Code Compliance. Violation of the Vacant Building Statute (Chapter 43) will result in the issuance of a criminal citation. This inspection can be obtained by calling Building Inspections and Design at (651) 266-9016.

THE VACANT BUILDING REGISTRATION FORM AND FEE MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE VACANT BUILDING PROGRAM BEFORE DSI WILL ISSUE ANY PERMITS.

Written permission from the City of Saint Paul is required before a Category 2 or Category 3 Vacant Building can be sold. Requirements which must be met for Category 2 Vacant Buildings include: 1. register/re-register the building; 2. Pay outstanding fees; 3. obtain a code compliance report; 4. submit for approval a rehab cost estimate from a licensed contractor and a schedule for completion of all code compliance work; 5. submit proof of financial responsibility acceptable to the City; and 6. obtain Zoning approval of the proposed use. In addition to meeting all 6 (six) of these requirements, a Category 3 Vacant Building must obtain a Certificate of Occupancy or a Certificate of Code Compliance prior to the sale of the building. Dear Property Representative:

Your building was determined to be a registered vacant building on October 16, 2018. Since certificates are for the occupancy of buildings, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- Water cooler NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as: room air 1. conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet. -
- 2. bedroom N E side - MSFC 1030.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room or area, or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Remove all storage that will prevent emergency escape through window in case of emergency-
- SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this 3. office.
- MSFC 901.8.1 It shall be unlawful for any person to remove, tamper with or otherwise 4. disturb smoke detectors-

- 5. MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials. -Remove charcoal and lighter fluid from house
- 6. MSFC 315.3.3 Remove combustible storage within 36 inches of fuel burning equipment. -
- 7. MSFC 603.5.3 Provide clearance around all mechanical equipment. -
