

1 An ordinance revising Legislative Code Chapter 91 pertaining to turn-on service charge.

3 THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL DOES ORDAIN:

5 Section 1.

7 That chapter 91 of Saint Paul Legislative Code is hereby amended as follows:

9 **Chapter 91. – Water Code – Miscellaneous Provisions**

11 **Sec. 91.13. – Turn-on service charge.**

13 (a) When water has been turned off for nonpayment of charges due, for any
14 infraction of rules or upon request of the owner or authorized agent, the water
15 may not be turned on again until a turn-on service charge in the amount of
16 \$50.00 has been paid ~~in accordance with the following Table for Turn-On~~
17 ~~Service Charge~~ or arrangements for payment have been made and approved by
18 the water utility.

19 ~~Table for Turn-On Service Charge~~

Through December 31, 2004	\$35.00
Beginning January 1, 2005	40.00

22 (b) If a water utility truck is dispatched to a property during established working
23 hours for the purpose of turning off the water service for nonpayment of
24 delinquent charges and the owner or tenant pays the delinquent charges rather
25 than have the water service terminated, a collections service fee equal in amount
26 to the current turn-on service charge shall be charged even though the water
27 service is not actually shut off.
28 (c) Whenever water has been turned off for nonpayment of charges due or for
29 infraction of the rules, all outstanding charges must be paid or arrangements for
30 payment must be made and approved by the water utility, in addition to the turn-
31 on service charge or collection service fee, before water is turned on again.
32 Water service will only be turned on during established working hours.

36 The other sections of Chapter 91 shall remain unchanged.

40 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force January 1, 2013, or thirty (30) days
41 following its passage, approval and publication, whichever occurs last.
