This is to confirm that our office has received your applications for variances from the city's noise ordinance and that they are being processed. The above-referenced event will have amplified music/sound at the following seven (7) locations along the Get Lucky Run race route, namely, CHS Field, 360 N. Broadway Street, Jackson and Shepard, Ontario and Shepard, Randolph and Shepard, Otto and Shepard, West of Otto and 400 Feet prior to the 35E underpass on Shepard, and Alton and Shepard Road with the use of a sound system, for the Get Lucky Run on Saturday, March 11, 2017 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of sound level variances. The Department of Safety and Inspections has recommended that variances be issued with conditions.

A public hearing on your request for variances has been scheduled for **Wednesday, February 15, 2017 at 5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
