A reinspection will be made on September 27, 2016 at 130pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

1. INTERIOR - UPPER LEVEL CEILING HEIGHT - SPLC 34.13 (1) - Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.-Ceiling height measured 6ft 10inches. The room has approved egress windows on both sides of room. It was a larger room and the "bedroom" measured 13.5ft x 20ft approximately.
