**NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 13, 2023.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 111.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office. ***There is a about a 10' section of the basement wall that has collapsed, all work for this damage will require licensed contractors and a permit to do the work. The permit or permits will need to be closed with the approved inspector. Call to schedule a re-inspection with this office prior to occupying the building.***
2. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke alarm affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
