Noise Source: Amber ACE Cleveland/ACEntertainment has applied for a sound level variance in order to provide music outdoors at the Union Depot North Plaza on Saturday, July 11, 2015, from 2:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check between 12:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance will be for the hours of 2:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. , with a pre-event sound check between 12:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. on July 11, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from sound source. 3) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices must be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
