Hello Adam:

Thank you for asking. The areas where the sprinkler spread or coverage is impacted by the chip board walls/ceiling may be replaced by a chain link fence or another material that does not inhibit the coverage of the sprinkler systems in the storage areas. Areas where a piece of the board has been cut away to allow for the sprinkler head would still impact the functioning of the sprinkler heads. That remedy is not accepted.
