### **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

# Sound Level Variance Wanderlust 108

#### Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

## **Description of Variance:**

**Location**: Harriet Island

Noise Source: Wanderlust Festival, LLC, has requested a sound level variance to provide the use of a sound system for music and announcements at Harriet Island for Wanderlust 108. The variance is requested at a sound level limit of 95-100 decibels (dBA), at no specified distance, for the hours of 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 30, and 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 1, 2017. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) the variance shall be for the hours of 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 30 and 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 1, 2017. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 30 and at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 1, 2017.
