I do understand that there was an open bottle of beer on the bar after the 2:30am rule, within a few minutes after 2:30am. It was 2:33am when the violation occurred. Please note: the bottle of beer was opened prior to 2am. Nevertheless; I understand the after hours display or consumption is a violation.

In addition, the power supply to the DVR Video box was not powered, this was NOT PURPOSELY done. I am extremely upset about the failure of the DVR and I feel that I am not at fault for the power outage. I did not say the DVR was unplugged, for some reason out of my control it was not getting power. I do not believe anyone would have "caused" the DVR not to have power, as it's in my locked office in a cabinet. I would like to contest this portion of the violation/modification of the license.
