Description of Variance:

Noise Source – The Metropolitan Council has requested a sound level variance to allow Central Corridor Light Rail construction 25 dates of overnight work, 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. between April 5, 2012 and December 31, 2012. The use of jack hammers, saw cutting, and other similarly loud activities will not be permitted during this time period with the exception of May 18, 19, and 20, 2012 when these activities will be permitted.

Location: Cedar Street between 11th and 12th; 12th between Cedar and Robert; Robert between 12th and University Avenue.
