On behalf of St. Paul Tap I would like to request removing the restriction of patio background music from the liquor license which remained as a result of the prior owners problems and mismanagement of Tav on the Ave.

In the spring of 2019 we constructed a new patio with a fully enclosed perimeter roller door wall system to eliminate any issues associated with sound that could disrupt our neighbors and as a result have had no problems with customer noise. I've included pictures of the roller door wall system and illustrations of the patio and new parking lot that were installed. With our roller door wall system and booths with overhead roofs it will be easy to tuck small speakers in them and have music on low for guests with no chance of the sound being heard on Jefferson Avenue and certainly not at neighboring homes.

We have worked diligently at improving the concept and operations over what once was at this location. Becoming a good partner to our neighbors has been our top priority and if granted the opportunity to have background music on our patio we will manage it closely to ensure that continues.
