Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on February 10, 2012, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on February 29, 2012 at 10:00 am or the property vacated. All permits for this work must be inspected and approved prior to this date.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Dryer UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- Provide inspection and approval under permit. Per legislative appeal, this work must be completed and approved under any necessary permits by January 15, 2012.
- 2. Basement MFGC 304 Provide approved combustion make up air in compliance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.- Provide inspection and approval under permit. Per legislative appeal, this work must be completed and approved under any necessary permits by January 15, 2012.

3. Lower Unit - SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 4715.0200.C - Provide an approved number and type of plumbing fixtures.-Provide and maintain an approved private hand sink. This work may require a permit(s).

Provide and maintain an approved kitchen sink. This work may require a permit(s). Provide and maintain an approved private tub or shower. This work may require a permit(s).

Per legislative appeal, this work must be completed and approved under any necessary permits by January 15, 2012. An inspection will be made after this date. Contact plumbing inspector for approval of permit for this work.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
