Dear Mr. Dockry:

The Saint Paul City Council adopted an Order to Remove or Repair the nuisance/dangerous building(s) at 1150 Reaney Avenue in Saint Paul within 180 days of January 20, 2017. The date the work was to be completed, per the Council resolution, was July 20, 2017. The measure of completion of the work and abatement of the nuisance/dangerous condition is the issuance of the Certificate of Code Compliance. To date, no certificate has been issued and the work remains incomplete. In order to make findings for Council consideration of the completeness of the work and need for city abatement of the nuisance/dangerous building(s), as well as the status of the performance deposit, a legislative hearing is being scheduled on **August 22, 2017 at 10 a.m. in Room 330 City Hall, 15 West Kellogg Blvd., Saint Paul.**

If your client has received the Certificate of Code Compliance by August 15, 2017, this hearing will be cancelled and a resolution will be forwarded to the City Council indicating the nuisance conditions have been abated and the matter is closed.

If your client has *not* received the Certificate of Code Compliance by August 11, 2017, they will need to work with Joe Yannarelly (joe.yannarelly@ci.stpaul.mn.us or 651-266-1920) to schedule an inspection to occur *prior to* the week of August 8, 2017. Both Mr. Yannarelly and a building inspector will conduct this inspection.

The findings of the Legislative Hearing will be considered at a City Council Public Hearing on Wednesday September 6, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. in City Council Chambers, Room 300 City Hall, 15 West Kellogg Blvd., Saint Paul.
