Ms. Moermond asked me to follow up with you after her conversation with you on the 24<sup>th</sup>. Currently the property has been ordered removed within 21 days of the 9/25 Council Public Hearing. During those 21 days you are allowed to be in the property between 8 am and 8 pm to do things like move your personal property. After those 21 days (October 21), you'll need to connect with Supervisor Joe Yannarelly (copied here or 651-266-1920) to make an appointment for access.

As Ms. Moermond mentioned, **prioritize marking and moving what items and things you wish to keep**, *do not* focus on cleaning out the property.
