**NOTICE OF INTENT TO DENY LICENSE**

Dear Obedo Normil:

The Department of Safety and Inspections will recommend denial of the Mobile Food Vehicle license application submitted by Obedo Normil d/b/a Obedo Normil for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is based on the following information:

**On November 15, 2012, you were sent a letter from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) stating that your Mobile Food Vehicle license application has been "pending" since June 5, 2012. The license would not be issued until you obtained a DSI Zoning Section inspection approval for the storage/parking location of your vehicle when it is not in use.**

**You were asked to submit a written explanation of where this vehicle will be kept when it is not in use by Friday, December 7, 2012. As of today's date, you have not submitted the documentation necessary to continue the application process and issue the license.**

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

1. You can submit the required written explanation of where your vehicle will be kept when it is not in use to Jeffrey Fischbach (651) 266-9106 no later than **Monday February 4, 2013**. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience.
2. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter no later than **Monday, February 4, 2013**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to deny your license. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.

3. You can withdraw your license application. Send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections at 375 Jackson Street, Suite 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday, February 4, 2013**. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Any request for a refund of the license application fees must also be made in writing to the Department of Safety and Inspections

**If you have not contacted me or DSI by Monday, February 4, 2013, I will assume that you do not contest the denial of your license. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.**
