Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was determined to be a registered vacant building on October 4, 2010. Since certificates are for the occupancy of buildings, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 2. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 3. SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.-Failure to provide access resulted in revocation of C of O.
- 4. SPLC 45.03 (6) Cut and maintain the grass/weeds less than 8 inches tall.
- 5. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Holes in wall on West side of structure.
