Noise Source: West End Festivals, St Paul Oktoberfest has requested a sound level variance, at no specified sound level limit, in order to present live music and announcements at Rice Park on Friday, September 16, 2016, Saturday, September 17, 2016, and Sunday, September 18, 2016. The variance is requested for the noise source on Friday, September 16, 2016 from 4:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m., Saturday, September 17, 2016 from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., and Sunday, September 18, 2016 from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for West End Festivals, St Paul Oktoberfest at Rice Park on September 16, September 17 and September 18, 2016. 2) Noise source of operation is 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Friday, September 16, 2016, from 10:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 17, 2016, and from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 18, 2016. 3) All electronically powered equipment, PA system, loudspeaker or any similar device used in conjunction with the event, will not exceed 85 dBA, as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source used for music and/or announcements. 4) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 5) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off by 10:00 p.m. on September 16 and September 17, 2016 and by 5:00 p.m. on September 18, 2016.

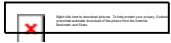

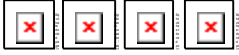
