Dear Interested Parties:

This is to confirm that at the Council Public Hearing on May 8, 2024 Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond will recommend that the Council **grant 180 days to rehabilitate the abovenamed property.** 

You may begin pulling permits immediately. Please remind your contractors that for Category 3 Vacant Buildings permits must be done **in person** at 375 Jackson, they cannot be done online. When your rehabilitation is complete and the property has received its Code Compliance certificate, you may request your performance deposit back in writing to Robert Humphrey at robert.humphrey@ci.stpaul.mn.us.

This matter will go before the City Council at Public Hearing on Wednesday, May 8, 2024 at 3:30 pm. in room 300 City Hall however no further action is needed and the Council will proceed with Ms. Moermond's recommendation above.

At the conclusion of the grant of time, the Council will receive a report from the Legislative Hearing Officer with findings on the status of the substantial abatement. You will receive a letter with the time and date of this hearing from our office approximately 5 and a half months following the date of your Council Public Hearing.
