Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on January 20, 2015 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on February 23, 2015 at 9:45 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Front Door Ext. Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition. Repair or replace the damaged screen door at the front of the house.
- 2. Exterior Front Door MSFC 308.2.1 No person shall throw or place, or cause to be thrown or placed, a lighted match, cigar, cigarette, matches, or other flaming or glowing substance or object on any surface or article where it can cause an unwanted fire.

- 3. Exterior Front Steps SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair. Front steps requires handrail.
- 4. Exterior Front of House SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Repair the holes and broken concrete on the front retaining wall.
- 5. Exterior Near Garage SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.
- 6. Interior Back Entry Door SPLC 34.09 (3) i Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.-Back entry door requires a lock to secure from illegal entry
- 7. Interior Back Entry Doorway SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door frame.-Replace the door frame around the back entry door.
- 8. Interior Basement MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-Place electrical covers on the junction boxes on the ceiling in the basement.
- 9. Interior Basement MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Plug the washing machine directly into an outlet.
- 10. Interior Basement Stairway SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate balustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.-Guardrails are needed for the stairway leading to the basement.
- 11. Interior Bathroom MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. Repair the GFCI outlet in the bathroom.
- 12. Interior East Bedroom MSFC 1028.3 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exit-way. Rearrange the room so that the bedroom window is not obstructed.
- 13. Interior East Bedroom Ext. Door SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.33 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-Repair the East bedroom door so that it does not stick to the door frame. Door must be able to open.

- 14. Interior East Bedroom MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
- 15. Interior Hallway MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. Move the Co detector in the kitchen and place in the hallway between the two bedrooms.
- 16. Interior Stairways SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.-Handrail are needed for the basement stairway and the attic stairway.
- 17. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 18. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
