Sound Level Variance Application Lowertown Guitar Festival Mears Park

HSR Events, represented by Steve Heckler, Executive Director has requested a sound level variance to provide music outdoors at Mears Park for the Lowertown Guitar Festival on Saturday, August 9, 2014.

Description of Variance:

Location: Event will be located outdoors at Mears Park

Noise Source: HSR Events has applied for a sound level variance in order to provide music outdoors at Mears Park on Saturday, August 9, 2014, from 12:00 Noon to 10:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) Variance will be for the hours of noon to 10:00 p.m. on August 9, 2014. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from sound source. 3) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
