Re: Application for Outdoor Service Area (Private Patio) License

Dear Ms. Schweinler:

We hereby request that a Liquor—Outdoor Service Area (Private Patio) license be added to our existing license.

We attach a consent petition from the owners of all private residences, dwellings and apartment houses located within 300 feet of the proposed service area, as well as a site plan showing the patio area.

The outdoor service area will be operated as follows:

1. The area will be enclosed by a continuous 4-foot plank-rail fence in character with the historic building.
2. Shrubs will be planted along the east fence line to help buffer the traffic noise from Smith Avenue (State Highway 13).
3. Entry will only be via the main (north/alley) entrance of the taproom/restaurant. Patrons will need to walk through the entrance vestibule and out the (south) exit door to access the outdoor service area.
4. Two gates (to the east and south) will provide emergency egress from the area, as required by code. The east egress gate will open to an ADA ramp leading down to the public sidewalk.
5. Four picnic tables seating eight patrons each, and four standing high-tops will be available.

6. All seating/standing areas will be covered with compressed crushed limestone, matching the character of the historic limestone building.
7. Beer and soda taps and a catering grill will be located behind a outdoor service counter at the southwest corner of the service area.
8. Dedicated servers with ServSafe training will provide outdoor counter service and monitor the area at all times.
9. A limited food menu (e.g., pretzels, bratwurst baskets, pepper popcorn, etc), beer and soda will be available.
10. Hours: 11am-9pm, Tuesday-Sunday
