




# In the month since we talked...

  - EUA for Pfizer (12+) approved, now awaiting Moderna decision
  - Positivity, case rates, hospitalization all declining
  - Governor ends mask mandate and capacity limits; St Paul and Minneapolis keep mask mandates (with recommendation of Public Health)
  - RECERT summer push
  - State of MN incentive program

# Fairgrounds vaccine site wrap up (ends June 8)

- Focus of this FEMA/State community vaccination center was to provide no barrier vaccination opportunities for Minnesotans.
- Goal: Vaccinate 105,000/84,000 Minnesotans in priority zip codes over 8 weeks
  - Significant improvement in vaccine uptake after inclusion of “walk-ins,” as well as some additional zip codes (55114, 55116, 55119)



The number of people confirmed to have or have had COVID-19, by date of test specimen collection.





# Goals

---

All zip codes (across County) at 55% uptake for 16+ population

55103 (met initial 55% goal – 57% on May 28)

55130 (at 52%). Anticipate meeting initial 55% goal around June 8

55106 (has met initial 55% goal – 57% on May 28)

% positivity rates (must remain at/under 7% for 4 weeks in a row... we've been under 7% since April 15, continuing to decline – at 6.04% currently)

Weekly case rate per 100,000 (7 day rolling average) remain 15 or lower (currently at 14.6% and declining).

# RECERT summer push

---

Our [Racial Equity & Community Engagement Response Team](#) (RECERT) has developed a plan to promote opportunities for vaccination for residents who have traditionally faced racial and health inequities.

- Includes a culturally focused and diverse multi-channel, multi-lingual advertising campaign, heavily focused on racially and ethnically diverse community media (heavily focused on 55130, 55106, and 55103). Messages in several languages will drive awareness of free vaccine availability.
- As Trusted Cultural Community Messengers and Connectors come online, we will partner with them to provide even more COVID-19 vaccine education, outreach, and recruitment.
