**NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on August 5, 2024.

The building was found to be unsafe, unfit for human habitation, a public nuisance, a hazard to the public welfare or otherwise dangerous to human life. A Condemnation Placard has been posted on the building.

The following deficiency list must be completed or the building vacated by the re-inspection date.

A reinspection will be made on or after January 1, 2026.

CONDEMNATION OF THE BUILDING REVOKES THE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY.

Failure to complete the corrections may result in a criminal citation. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Throughout - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 111.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-The property is condemned due to extensive fire damage throughout. Repairs shall require permits. Call DSI directly at 651-266-8989 to obtain the appropriate permits.

2. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke alarm affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
