

Good Afternoon,

I have conferred with Dori Dufresne in Planning and George Gause in historic preservation. The chimney repair does not require a permit and I did not require oversight to effect the repair. (Email chain contained below as verification).

The intact flue liner is actually visible from the photos and you can see there is no corrosion. If that is still of concern I will ask the company that performed the ORSAT testing; Testing LLC about emissions from the flue liner. Dori seemed to indicate that this may not be needed as the code refers to chimneys without a flue liner and the emissions concern would be on the interior and not the exterior.



The tenant is set to have her pregnancy induced on Thursday so I am trying to line up help to go in and patch those few bare spots in the carpet. The rest of the work has been done. It's simply a matter of verification.

Would you be willing to accept photos from the tenant to verify completion? If so, we may be able to get the interior handled quickly without disturbing the residents.

PS I contacted Testing LLC that performed the ORSAT and they are finishing up the report now. I expect to be able to send that to you tomorrow.

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
