A re-inspection will be made on December 21, 2016 at 9:30 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. CORRODED SPRINKLER HEADS MSFC 901.6 Contact a fire sprinkler contractor to replace all painted or damaged fire sprinkler heads. All sprinkler work must be done by a licensed contractor under permit.
 - -Replace corroded sprinkler heads along the skyway windows, elevator lobby and level 2 drive lanes. This work will require a permit.
- 2. MAIN ENTRANCE MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the exit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.
 - -Access control is not approved.
