### Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 23, 2017, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

#### A re-inspection will be made on November 21, 2017 at 11:00 AM or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

1. Exterior - Parking Surface - SPLC 34.08 (7) - All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.

The parking surface on the left side of the garage has been improperly cover with the wrong type of gravel and the surface underneath is dirt. There is a large mound of crushed concrete on the ground. Immediately contact DSI Zoning Division at 651-266-8989 for more information.

- SPLC 40.06. Suspension, revocation and denial. (A) Grounds for revocation. The fire code official may, in writing, issue a notice to the owner(s) and known interested parties of the city's suspension or revocation of a fire certificate of occupancy issued under the provisions of this code, or deny an application therefor;
   (3) if it found upon inspection of the fire code official that the building or occupancy is violation of provisions of this or other applicable safety code, ordinances, rules or regulations; The Fire Certificate of Occupancy has been revoked due to long term non-compliance.
- 3. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
