Dear Mr. Holmes:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended denial of the Massage Practitioner license application submitted by Gregory Q. Holmes for the premises located at 2140 Ford Parkway. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On September 27, 2012, you were sent a letter from the Department of Safety and Inspections stating the application you submitted for a Massage Practitioner license has been pending since July 26, 2012.

Your license application is pending because you have not submitted either a notarized copy of current certification in Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork or successful completion of written and practical examinations from the City of Saint Paul authorized examiner.

You were given until October 29, 2012 to submit this information, as of today's date it has not been received.

At this time you have three options on how to proceed:

1. You can submit the requested information listed above. If this is your choice, please send it to the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) at 375 Jackson Street, Suite 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday, February 4, 2013**. A self-addressed envelope is included for your convenience. Submission of the requested information will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.

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2. If you wish admit the facts but contest the denial, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council, you will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting the facts and requesting a public hearing. We will need to receive your letter by **Monday, February 4, 2013**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to deny your license. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
3. You may withdraw your license application. Send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Suite 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806, no later than **Monday, February 4, 2013**. A self-addressed envelope is included for your convenience. Any request for a refund of the license application fee must also be made in writing to the Department of Safety and Inspections.

If you have not contacted me by Monday, February 4, 2013, I will assume that you do not contest the denial of your license. In that case, the matter will be placed on the Council's Consent Agenda for approval of the denial.
