The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.-2 Freezers on

power strip.

Living room - MSFC 605.4 - Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-Replace with power strip if needed.

3. North bedroom - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the window in good condition.-Window does not open.

4. North bedroom - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Double hung window opening.

Height 47 in. - Width 23 in.
