CORRECTION NOTICE - RE-INSPECTION COMPLAINT

Dear Property Representative:

A re-inspection was made on your building on October 29, 2024, in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiencies must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on or after December 2, 2024.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior - Backyard - SPLC 34.08 (6) - Remove the accumulation of exterior storage that creates a nuisance or harbors rodents. -Brush pile in backyard including yard waste
2. Exterior - Garage - SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.32 (3) - All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. Service doors to accessory structures shall be provided with securing locks. -Garage is leaning toward alley - doors are not secured closed - cracked, chipped, and peeling paint - doors are water damaged

3. Exterior - Garage - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 111.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office. **-Condemned for but not limited to garage is leaning toward alley - structural integrity is compromised - work shall be completed under permit**
4. Exterior - MSFC 304.1 - Remove excessive combustible storage and/or vegetation from exterior property areas. -Multiple items in alley next to garage and in yard - brush pile in backyard including yard waste
