NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND LICENSES

Dear Mr. Rashid:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended suspension of all licenses held by AM PM Gas d/b/a Marathon Market for the premises located at 719 Payne Avenue in Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) records indicate that your licenses have been delinquent since June 20, 2010. You now owe \$1,428.00 in delinquent license and late fees.

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

- 1. You can pay the \$1,428.00 in delinquent license and late fees. If this is your choice, you should send the payment and information directly to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Thursday**, **November 18, 2010**. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Payment of the delinquent license and late fees will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
- 2. If you wish to admit the facts but contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council, you will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting the facts and requesting a public hearing. We will need to receive your letter by **Thursday**, **November 18**, **2010**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to suspend your licenses. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.

3. If you no longer wish to do business in the City of Saint Paul, you will need to send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Thursday**, **November 18, 2010**. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek.

If you have not contacted me by that date, I will assume that you do not contest the suspension of your licenses. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
