Good Morning,

HouseCalls has been working with Nicole Warner. We assisted her in getting a hotel for 5 nights after learning that Child Protection would not allow the children to continue to stay in the home with her. We have attempted to assist her in getting the children's clothing/bedding/towels/ laundered and salvaged from the conditions of this home. Unfortunately, we will not be able to assist. I have included Schar Ward's comments'. ..

'Ok, not many jobs I turn down but this is one of them. My advice would be to give her the money it would cost to do the laundry and let her buy new things. The basement we would need biohazard equipment to deal with it and the roaches are so bad it would cost you way more than House calls could afford.. Everything in the house needs to be thrown out and the house torn down. Sorry.'

We will do what is possible within our resources to assist the family. There is a dumpster delivered to the home, however, there will be no assistance in cleaning up that home due to the severe conditions. Sade assisted in having animal control pick up 5 cats and a dog from the home yesterday. Child Protection informed me yesterday that this case will be referred to one of their 'on-going' units.

I wanted to share the information that I know.
