Locations: Parking lots of 377, 394 and 422 University Avenue West

Noise Source: The Asian Economic Development Association has applied for a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 90 decibels (dBA) at a distance of 50 feet from any stage or sound source, in order to present various activities such as amplified music, performances, and announcements, on three outdoor stages, located in the parking lots of 377, 394 and 422 University Ave West for the Little Mekong Night Market on Saturday, June 10, 2017 from 5:00 p.m. until midnight and on Sunday, June 11, 2017 from 5:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 12:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) recommends the following conditions: 1) The variance will be for the Little Mekong Night Market on three outdoor stages, as listed above, on Saturday, June 10, 2017 from 5:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. and on Sunday, June 11, 2017 from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from noon to 5:00 p.m. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices used in conjunction with the event must not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from any stage or sound source from 5:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. on June 10 and June 11, 2017; and must not exceed 85 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source from 10:01 p.m. until 11:59 p.m. on Saturday, June 10, 2017. 3) The applicant will provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices must be turned off no later than 11:59 p.m. Saturday, June 10, 2017 and 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 11, 2017.

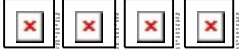
