Dear Sir/Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on October 3, 2025 and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

- 1. SPLC 34.19. **ACCESS:** Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building. PLEASE PROVIDE ACCESS TO THE INSPECTOR TO THE REAR YARD AND INSIDE THE CAMPER TRAILER THANK YOU.
- 2. SPLC 45.03. EXTENSION CORDS: Immediately, discontinue use of frayed, deteriorated, damaged, or spliced electrical cords adequate to meet the building's needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-9090.

PLEASE DISCONNECT AND REMOVE ALL EXTENSION CORDS FROM THE CAMPER TRAILER AND FROM THE ENTIRE PROPERTY. EXTENSION CORDS SHALL NOT BE USED IN LIEU OF ELECTRICITY THANK YOU.

3. SPLC 34.14. - ILLEGAL DWELLING. Remove the illegal occupancy from inside the camper trailer.

CAMPER TRAILERS ARE NOT PERMANENT HABITABLE STRUCTURES. PLEASE IMMEDIATELY VACATE THE INSIDE OF THE CAMPER TRAILER. <u>FAILURE TO VACATE</u> THE INSIDE OF THE CAMPER TRAILER <u>MAY RESULT IN FINES</u>. THANK YOU.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after October 10, 2025 by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in an abatement and /or additional fees for re-inspection.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk's Office at (651) 266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of the date of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)

If you have any questions or request additional information concerning this matter, please contact Inspector Willie Williams, at (651) 266-1942. To arrange an appointment or request an extension of time to complete repairs, you will need to speak directly to the inspector.
