The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **August 14, 2025** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

1. SPLC 34.08 (2). - **DRAINAGE**: Please re-direct your drainage away from the public sidewalk/street. Your current direction is causing a nuisance and you are not authorized to have discharge to any street, sidewalk, alley, or right-of-way. This interferes or renders dangerous for passage on the public sidewalk, street, or alley.

YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO DRAIN YOUR GUTTERS ONTO THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY.

PLEASE IMMEDIATELY REMOVE THE UNDERGROUND PVC PIPES THAT ARE RUNNING UNDER THE RETAINING WALL/ FENCE AND ONTO THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY.

YOUR DOWNSPOUT DISCHARGE MUST BE DIRECTED TO THE FRONT AND REAR YARD AND NOT TOWARD THE PROPERTY BOUNDARY. THANK YOU.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after **August 25, 2025**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in an abatement and /or additional fees for re-inspection. USA - 1940
