Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on August 27, 2012 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on September 27, 2012 at 10:00 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Exterior garage - SPLC 71.01 - The address posted is not visible from alley. -Address on garage needs to be visible from the alley.
2. Exterior rear storm door. - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the door in good condition. -Repair screen on storm door in rear of building.
3. Interior basement - MSFC 605.6 - Provide all openings in junction boxes to be sealed. - Cover opening in fuse box on right side with approved material.

4. Interior basement - UMC 1002 Repair, replace or install duct work in compliance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- Replace duct tape on duct work for dryer.
5. Interior basement - SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 - This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office. -Vacate basement apartment. Owner informed inspector that he had constructed the apartment without obtaining permits; apartment is also lacking emergency escape and rescue opening.
6. Interior unit 1 - SPLC 34.09 (3) i - Repair and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock. -Deadbolt needs to have thumb latch installed on it, lock located on front door of the unit.
7. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
