NARRATIVE

On August 20, 2020 at 0121 hours I, Officer B. McAlpine (Squad 124) responded to 54 Syndicate Street South on a burglary in progress. Call comments stated an unknown male smashed the window and got into the Salon across from the complainant. Suspect is an unknown race male, short, with a tiny pony tail and was last seen Southbound on Syndicate Street.

Upon arrival I observed the glass on the front door was smashed and drawers to the front counter were on the floor. Squad 129 (Bierwerth, see supplement report) arrived, we cleared the business and did not locate anyone inside. Officer Bierwerth spoke with the complainant and gathered a statement as well as found a donation jar down the street.

I was able to contact an employee who was identified as BARDEN, NANCY (54 Syndicate Street South St Paul, MN 55105, C/P: 651-247-0808). BARDEN responded to the business and advised the only thing stolen was the donation jar which was located nearby with a one dollar bill next to it. BARDEN stated it may of contained up to twenty dollars.

I located one camera on the South side of the building which faces the parking lot.

I contacted data and had a board up crew respond.

NARRATIVE

On 08/20/2020 at 0125 hours, I, squad 129, Ofc. Bierwerth, was dispatched to 54 Syndicate Street South to assist squad 124, Ofc. B. McAlpine on a burglary in progress call.

I arrived and assisted Ofc. McAlpine with searching the business for suspects. We searched the business and found it to be unoccupied.

I spoke to the witness/complainant, verbally identified as MARY BETH BERNDT (DOB: 07/20/1963, 1280 Grand Avenue, # 201, St. Paul, MN 55105, C/P: 651-210-6352), who told me the following statement. BERNDT said she was asleep when she woke up to a pounding noise coming from outside of her apartment building. She continued to say she looked out of her window and observed a unknown person breaking into the business at 54 Syndicate Street. BERNDT said it was dark and difficult to see but was able to say there was only one male suspect, he was short, and had short hair pulled back into a pony tail. She was unable to provide any details regarding the suspect's weight, age, race, or clothing description. BERNDT said once the suspect gained entry into the business he wasn't inside very long and then exited and began walking southbound on

Syndicate Street. BERNDT advised the male appeared to stop near a red colored truck that was parked in the rear (north side) of 1279 Lincoln Ave. BERNDT said she thought the suspect might have dropped something near the truck.

BERNDT told me a short time after seeing the suspect near the red truck she advised she saw an older, darker colored SUV come northbound on Syndicate and then travel eastbound on Grand. BERNDT advised she was not certain the suspect got into the SUV but she personally believed he did. She was unable to provide any additional information about the SUV.

I walked down near the red truck and observed a broken clear plastic case or container on the sidewalk. I also observed a single dollar bill laying on the sidewalk near by. I believed those items came from inside the burglarized business. I photographed the items, recovered them, and brought them back to the business. The items were handed over to the a business employee who arrived a short time later.

I later uploaded the photographs to the secure SPPD media vault.
