Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

- 2. EXTERIOR FRONT STEPS SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.- Replace defective concrete steps front entry.
- 3. EXTERIOR WALLS ETC SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration.

All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Repair stucco walls.

Scrape and repaint painted areas where paint deteriorate, worn away, flaking etc.

- 5. INTERIOR CO/SDA SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 6. INTERIOR EXIT OBSTRUCTIONS MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction.

Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-

Remove all items from exit passageways etc throughout building.

- 7. INTERIOR HEATING REPORT SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 8. INTERIOR FRONT PORCH EXCESSIVE MATERIALS MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.- Excessive accumulation of materials on front porch.

 Remove minimum of 50 per cent of materials.
